Why pray the Stations of the Cross?

The Stations of the Cross help us to focus our hearts and minds on Jesus' suffering and death. Walking through each station we see how he responded to suffering and we are challenged to respond more as Jesus would when we are weighed down by life's burdens. Pope Francis writes 'How many people were with Jesus on the way to Calvary: Pilate, Simon of Cyrene, Mary, the women... Sometimes we can be like Pilate, who did not have the courage to go against the tide to save Jesus' life, and instead washed his hands. Dear friends, the Cross of Christ teaches us to be like Simon of Cyrene, who helped Jesus to carry that heavy wood; it teaches us to be like Mary and the other women, who were not afraid to accompany Jesus all the way to the end, with love and tenderness. And you? Who are you like? Like Pilate? Like Simon? Like Mary?'
